The Regional Coordinators of NCDVD assist the executive board in their mission to support and serve the vocations offices in each member diocese. Regional Coordinators fulfill their mission through good communication, sharing personal expertise in vocations work, and setting a good example.

= Tasks =

- ~ Organize and lead regional meetings
- ~ Communicate with the Vice President and the Executive Board of NCDVD
- ~ Communicate with members of the region to assist them in their ministry, to relay information from the national office, and to respond to challenges, opportunities, and issues that arise
- ~ Welcome new vocation directors to the region and offer them assistance

Travel Commitments

Regional Coordinators are expected to attend the annual pre-convention regional coordinator meeting held each September preceding the national conference.

Guidelines for Choosing Your Next Regional Coordinator

- ~ The regional coordinator has an important role in the NCDVD. Choose someone who has a few years of experience as a vocation director
- ~ The regional coordinator extends the ministry and mission of the executive board of the NCDVD. Choose one who has been an active member of the NCDVD for at least a few years
- ~ Choose a regional coordinator who is willing and able to fulfill the role well by attending to the tasks and travel commitments
